Program Overview

This program is intended primarily for members of Religious Orders with women and men from different cultural backgrounds.

It is about the challenge of living interculturally: that is, with and through rather than in spite of our different cultures. We need to embrace the dignity of difference, but to do so we first need to understand cultural dynamics and what makes people who they are.

We will proceed systematically establishing a common vocabulary by explaining culture, crosscultural, multicultural and intercultural -- in a theological context. Then we will examine the apparent paradox that we human beings are both all the same and all different. We will consider the implications of the fact that we can only live our faith culturally (that is, in a culturally-shaped fashion). Consequently, in a community of people of different cultures, we need to take this fact very seriously and respond appropriately. Just as I cannot live my faith through your culture, so you cannot live your faith through mine, and vet we are called to live a common faith. Furthermore, as time passes, our exposure to other cultures should help re-shape our way of living our faith culturally.

As we work through some of these issues, we will also make time for a good deal of (light-hearted) table-talk and reflection.

About Our Presenter

FR. ANTHONY GITTINS, CSSp—Born in Manchester, England, Father Gittins is a member of the Congregation of the Holy Spirit (CSSp), and Professor Emeritus at the Catholic Theological Union in Chicago. There he has held the Bishop Ford Chair of Mission Theology, and is currently Professor of Theology and Culture. He has taught, lectured, offered workshops or given retreats in more than thirty countries from Africa to the Pacific. He has served as a hospital Chaplain, worked for more than a decade among the Mende people of Sierra Leone, West Africa, and works among and with homeless women on the streets of Chicago. He is the author of fifteen books on theological and anthropological topics, and on mission and spirituality including: Ministry At The Margins: Strategy and Spirituality for Mission A Presence That Disturbs: A Call to Radical Discipleship Come, Follow Me: The Commandments of Jesus, Living Mission Interculturally: Faith, Culture and the Renewal of Praxis.

FROM CLEVELAND: (and other points West)

- Take Ohio turnpike (I-80 EAST) to Exit 218
